The **Essential Supply Center** is a place where Plymouth's formerly homeless residents can come to obtain essential items they might not otherwise be able to afford. All of Plymouth's residents are very-low income—the majority of them make less than \$7,500 per year—and each month many have a hard time making ends meet.

Please consider making a donation to Plymouth's Essential Supply Center. Non-perishable foods and personal care items, such as canned goods, pasta, toothpaste and toothbrushes, provide short-term relief to our residents in temporary crisis. Donations help Plymouth maintain the health of these residents that can be compromised by poor nutrition and hygiene.

The Essential Supply Center can also use your help in keeping the shelves stocked with household goods. Many of our residents move into housing after years of homelessness and have very few or no items to set up their new home. Donations of gently used, clean household goods, such as linens, kitchenware and cleaning supplies, help our residents create a comfortable and stable home.
